A 25-year-old man presented to the emergency department with 1-hour history of numbness of all his extremities, progressing to left arm and leg pain. On arrival he had bradycardia and was somnolent. Medical history included cannabis use, and no previous alcohol or prescription drug use. Patient arrived in a confused state. Blood pressure was 90/52mm Hg, pulse was 42, respiratory rate was 12, oxygen saturation was 92% on air, and he was reported to be in respiratory distress. On arrival in the emergency department, he was given 1000mg of rectal paracetamol, 100mg of intravenous (IV) naloxone, IV fluids, and IV phenytoin. Paracetamol was given IV as he could not tolerate oral, and phenytoin was started as he had been somnolent. Phenytoin had to be stopped after 5 hours as his serum concentration was elevated at 1000μ g/L. Within 2 hours of presentation he became haemodynamically unstable and was transferred to intensive care unit where he was intubated, had an intravenous infusion of midazolam and morphine, and was commenced on noradrenaline infusion. Tachypnea persisted, and a tracheostomy was performed. On day 3, he was extubated, he received IV phenytoin 2d92ce491b
