

Polishing

Dusting

Dusting on a daily basis is a good way to ensure that your furniture stays in good shape. Set aside 10 minutes a day to dust your wooden furniture, with deeper cleaning to be done on weekends. This prevents accumulation of dust, which looks a lot more prominent on dark, wooden pieces

Usage of coasters

In order to avoid glass stains, try making use of coasters as much as possible. This reduces the clean-up after every use, which can get quite tedious and frustrating.

Keep out of sunlight

Direct sunlight can affect the finish of a wooden product. Try avoiding keeping the item in direct sunlight, or drape it with a throw for the hottest parts of the day

Some other tips:

- ✓ If you have pets at home, take necessary steps to protect your furniture.
- ✓ Avoiding keeping wood furniture in areas which are prone to humidity (such as bathrooms)

- ✓ Ensure the temperature at home is maintained. Drastic fluctuations can impact the humidity at home, thus creating dew which is not ideal for wooden furniture
- ✓ On the other hand, do not let your house get excessively dry. Dryness can make wood shrink, or makes it split
- ✓ Avoid direct contact with liquids such as water. Soft soap and a little water is ok, but excess of this and it has high chances of ruining your furniture!

Pick the right kind of fabric

Choosing the right type of fabric makes the maintenance task easier, and this solely depends on your lifestyle. For instance, synthetic fibers are a better option for upholstered pieces which are used heavily. Similarly, if you have pets avoid going for fabrics which have loose threads/weaves

Protect the fabric

Usually, fabrics are extremely susceptible to stains. Thus, pay close and great attention to spills regularly. If you end up spilling something, make sure you clean it up quickly and follow the instructions on how to clean it effectively

Turn the cushions

Turning cushions is commonly done in many households, and, for a good reason! The life of any upholstered furniture can be extended if you regularly turn the cushions over. This is because, the wear and tear gets evenly distributed on all sides and thus, reduces sag and wear and tear.

Use a vacuum cleaner

The fun part about vacuum cleaners is that they clean out every speck of dust on the surface! If used effectively on fabrics, it sucks in any particles, such as dust, unwanted food specks, and more. You can use a vacuum on your upholstered furniture every week to give it a general cleaning

Always remember to wipe glass dry

After using or cleaning a table top with a glass top, wipe it completely dry. If you leave the glass unattended when wet, it leaves marks which cannot be removed easily. Why invest in stronger buffs or chemicals when you can just wipe the product clean after each use?

Stay away from hard water

Use purified or distilled water while cleaning your glass furniture. Hard water consists of mineral residue which can leave marks. This is one of the primary reasons you can go for water mixed soap sprays to clean glass furniture

Microfiber or chamois cloth for cleaning glass

Using a daily used cloth or tissue can leave several lint particles or paper residue on the glass. Instead, go for microfiber or chamois cloth, which is specifically made for such purposes.
