

How To Select Grass Seed for Different Climatic Regions



Before establishing a healthy and charming landscape, it is essential to understand the region's climate. Landscapes and parks are greatly affected by the climate they are maintained in. Therefore it is important to understand the regional areas before contacting a <u>turf grass seed supplier</u>.

A turf grass seed supplier would have the domain knowledge of how different seeds would thrive in different environments; however, as a golf course, park, or sports field groundskeeper, having the right information will ensure a healthy landscape along with providing regular maintenance. This blog discusses different regions and how different seeds are suited to each region.

Northeast Region

If the landscape exists within the northeast region, it is good to ask grass seed suppliers about cool-season grasses. Northeast parks and landscapes would require grasses that thrive well in colder climates and are able to resist the harsh winters.

Grass seed companies will offer grasses such as bluegrasses, ryegrass, and fescue, which are highly ideal for the temperatures of the northeast region. Grass seed



suppliers often provide further insight into how to keep these grasses lush green once the seed has been sown to establish or maintain a landscape.

Midwest Region

The Midwest region is known for its variation in humidity. Unlike the north, the area frequently has to deal with periods of aridness; therefore, seeking grasses from grass seed companies that can thrive in fluctuating seasonal conditions becomes essential to maintain the beauty of the landscape.

Grass seed suppliers recommend bluegrasses for such a region. However, ryegrass and fescues can be ideal if proper irrigation is set up for the grass during the arid seasons. In the Midwest, during drought season, extra care should be taken care of the grasses regardless of the seeds to ensure that the landscape does not appear to be shriveled.

Southeast Region

The Southeast region is probably the warmest and most humid zone; therefore, landscape and park owners should consider seeking warm-season seeds from grass seed suppliers. Not only that, but the soil of the southeast region is often saline and prone to drought, like the Midwest region. Landscape owners are advised to invest in resilient grasses such as Bermuda grass which can survive in such extreme conditions.

Southwest Region

Maintaining a landscape in the Southwest region is challenging. The region is hot with a variety of elevations, saline water, and alkaline soil. Landscape and park owners need to provide a constant supply of fresh water in order to keep their golf courses, parks, and landscapes lush green and need to choose resilient grasses like Bermuda grass to maintain or establish their landscape.
