Question 1: What can I use Cricut cardstock material for?

Answer: You can use this material to make amazing crafts or projects such as greeting cards or gift tags. If you want to use smooth cardstock that is easy to write on using Cricut pens, you can make beautiful green cards using this. Moreover, cardstock can be used to make 3D projects hassle-free.

Question 2: What is the thickness of cardstock that Cricut can cut?

Answer: The maximum thickness of cardstock that you can cut on your Cricut machine is 2.4 mm. Do not exceed this recommended thickness for your cardstock; otherwise, you will not be able to cut it properly on your Cricut. However, Cricut Maker can easily cut 2.4 thick cardstock in one go.

Question 3: Why should I use cardstock?

Answer: Cardstock paper is heavier and sturdier than standard or regular paper. This is also the best choice for paper crafting and card marking, such as greeting cards and invitation cards. Due to its durability, I use such paper for business cards, playing cards, postcards, catalog covers, and scrapbooking. Its durability and ability to make cards easily are the main reasons you should use it over other paper.
