Depending on the weather, your ballooning path could take you north of Jaipur, above Amber Fort and village. You could instead fly above Samode Palace and village or Jal Mahal, Shiv Vilas and Delhi-Jaipur road if the winds are favourable. Please keep in mind that this is subject to the weather and winds at the time of your flight. To ensure a safe and comfortable hot air balloon ride for everyone aboard, the pilot determines the launch site and flying route based on weather conditions.



How to reach Jaipur?

Hot air balloon flights in Jaipur take place in many parts of the city and allow you to soar above gorgeous landmarks and ancient forts. SkyWaltz Balloon Safaris provides comfortable pick-up and drop-off services to and from your Jaipur hotel.

► The nearest railway station is located in the city centre of Jaipur, and trains travel daily to and from all parts of India.

► Jaipur Airport is located on the outskirts of Jaipur, 10 kilometers from the city centre. Daily flights are accessible from major Indian cities.

➤ Sindhi Camp, Jaipur's primary bus station, is located nearby. Buses go on a daily basis to and from neighbouring metropolises. The Yamuna highway connects Jaipur to Delhi, which is 272 kilometres away.

Hot Air Balloon Ride Timings

The rides are often scheduled two hours before sunrise and two hours after sunset. These times are good for the hot air balloon to fly because the winds are light, allowing for a calm flight. The typical hot air balloon activity times are the wee hours of the morning and evening.

Ride Duration

The flight usually lasts around an hour. However, the entire time spent getting ready, inflating the balloon, and launching it is approximately 3 hours.
