

How to Make Labels With Cricut: A Step-by-Step Guide

You can use two methods to make the labels. The first method is by using vinyl. After cutting the material, you transfer it to the boxes. The second method is to use a Cricut pen to print on the material. Once made, you can apply it to the boxes. In this write-up, I will be showing the vinyl method. So, let's start with the supplies and tools you will require for Cricut labels.

What Materials Do I Need to Make Labels?

To learn [how to make labels with Cricut](#), you must first know the materials and tools you are going to need. These items will be required to create labels using Cricut vinyl.

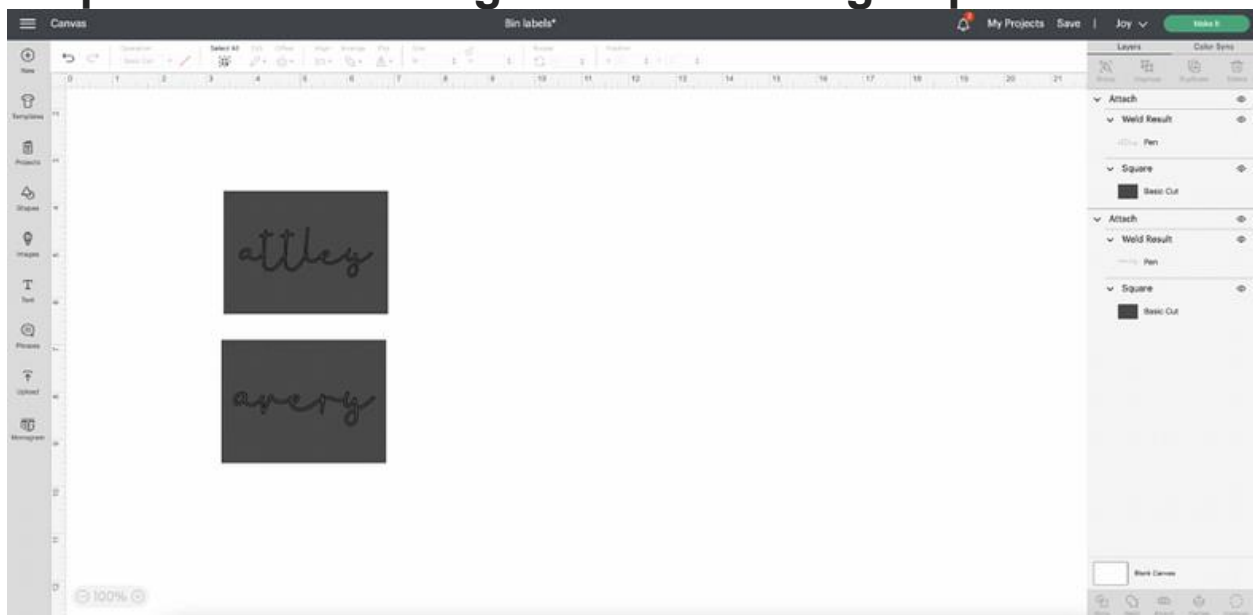
- **Cricut cutting machine:** To make labels, you can use Cricut Maker, Explore, or Joy machine. You need the machine to cut your design.

- **Cutting mat:** A mat is very important as you need it to put the material on before you place it inside the Cricut machine.
- **Premium Cricut vinyl:** It is the material to cut the designed font and then place it on your boxes.
- **Weeding tools:** You need this tool to peel your design from the material.
- **Transfer tape:** A transfer tape is used to transfer the design to the boxes or its destined place.

How to Make Labels With Cricut: 4 Easy Steps

Once you have collected all the required items to make labels, you can proceed to make them. There are four simple steps to crafting these labels, which I will describe in simple but detailed terms.

Step 1: Create a Design in Cricut Design Space



To write on labels, the first thing you need to do is pick a font in the [Cricut Design Space app](#). Next, you can customize the shape and size of the font, edit it however you like, and then cut it with the machine. Not only can you choose a font from the Cricut software, but you can also upload any design or font to the app. For example, you can create a design on your computer or phone and then upload it to the app.

One thing to keep in mind while making a design is to choose a simple font that you can easily weed after cutting. Also, consider the size of the label in relation to the size of the box. It should neither be too small nor too large to ensure it looks good.

Step 2: Cut the Labels on Your Cricut Machine

Once the design is ready and you are learning **how to make labels with Cricut**, click on “**Make It**” in the Design Space app. After that, the software will arrange all the words in the best possible way to minimize material waste. To start cutting, put the Cricut vinyl on the cutting mat and then load it into your machine. When everything is set, press the “**Load**” button on the machine. After the cutting procedure, you have to unload your machine and then take off the mat.

Step 3: Weed Out Your Design

After the cutting is done, peel off the labels from the material. Use the Cricut weeding tool to ensure precise peeling without damaging the label material. This tool is designed for accurate weeding.

Step 4: Transfer the Labels to the Surface

Once the weeding is complete, apply transfer tape to the top of the label sheet. Use a scraper tool on the transfer tape to make sure the vinyl letters stick well. Now, cut the labels, and they will be ready for transfer to your surface.

Then, place the label on the surface exactly where you need it. Once satisfied with the placement, flip the paper and peel the backing paper. Afterward, flip the label back and use the scraper on the transfer tape to ensure it sticks well. Finally, peel off the transfer tape, and your label will be complete.
