Once the design is cut, use a weeding tool to take off any unwanted parts. Once the design is ready, put it on your shirt and then apply heat using a heat press or Cricut Easy Press.





Finally, it is time to apply heat to your shirt. Lay the shirt flat on a surface and make sure there are no wrinkles. Next, place the iron-on vinyl design on the shirt. Before applying heat, preheat your Easy Press machine by setting the temperature in the Cricut app and allowing the machine to heat up.
