Here are a few places to look out for when you're up in the sky on your balloon trip.

City Palace

The pink-coloured majestic palace in the city centre is clearly the city's showpiece. Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II built this regal palace in 1727. View this UNESCO World Heritage Site from above. It is one of India's most extensive instances of Mughal architecture, blending Indian and Persian influences. A panoramic perspective of this palace allows you to glimpse areas of it that would otherwise be hidden from view from the ground.

Jal Mahal

The Jal Mahal is an archaeological marvel without a doubt. Built in the midst of Man Sagar Lake, four of the five storeys are submerged in water, while the top-level appears to float on the lake's surface. The palace's entrance is restricted. That's when your hot air balloon journey will allow you to explore all the hidden sights!

Hawa Mahal

Hawa Mahal, Jaipur's most famous landmark, is a lattice of 953 tiny windows that resembles a honeycombed hive. It was intended for the royal ladies to observe daily life and festivities celebrated on the streets without being noticed by the general people. From your hot air balloon ride, you can admire the palace in the golden glow of the morning sun.

Nahargarh fort


Resting on the edge of the Aravali hills, the Nahargarh fort exudes the stories of its past and rich history. Overlooking the vast city of Jaipur, the fort stands tall in its grandeur. As your hot air balloon rises up, you can see the walls of the fort that sweep across miles nestled in the lush greenery of the hills.

Jantar Mantar

If astronomy fascinates you, Jantar Mantar should be on your bucket list in Jaipur. This

historic astronomy observatory is where you can learn about how people used sundials to tell time. The extensive property contains a collection of architectural astronomical devices that were used for a variety of purposes, such as forecasting dawn and sunset times and determining the location of the pole star in relation to other celestial bodies.
