What Are Lice?

Lice are tiny blood-feeding parasites.

Common in children but can affect adults too.

Spread through direct contact and shared personal items.



Types of Lice

Head Lice: Found primarily on the scalp.

Body Lice: Live on clothing and only visit the skin to feed.

Pubic Lice: Known as 'crabs' and found in coarse body hair.



Recognizing Lice Infestation

Key Symptoms:

Sensation of something crawling.

Intense itching, especially at the back of the head and neck.

Visible nits or lice on the scalp or hair.



Causes of Lice

Direct Contact

Head-to-head contact, especially among children.

Shared Items

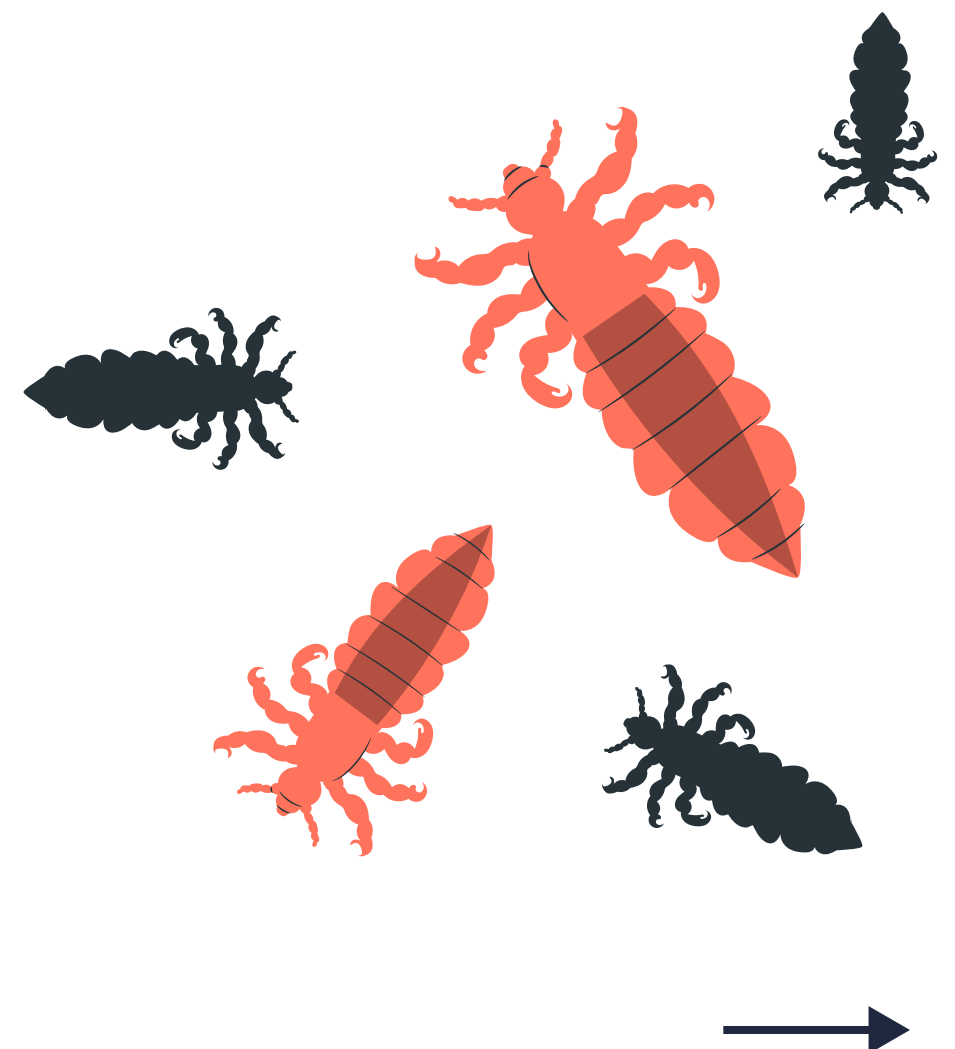
Combs, brushes, hats, and other personal items.

Sexual Contact

Mainly spreads pubic lice.

Poor Hygiene

Infrequent washing of hair or personal items.



Preventive Measures



Personal Items

Avoid sharing personal items like combs and hats.



Hygiene

Regular hair washing and cleaning of personal items.



Clean Environment

Disinfect bedding, clothing, and furniture regularly.



Treatment Options



Over-the-Counter Medications

Permethrin and Ivermectin.



Home Remedies

Wet combing, essential oils, and petroleum jelly.



Professional Treatment

Prescribed by doctors based on severity.
